GAMBARAN KESESUAIAN SYARAT MP-ASI KEMENKES PADA ANAK USIA 12-24 BULAN DI WILAYAH KERJA PUSKESMAS BENOWO SURABAYA

Kementerian Kesehatan menyatakan bahwa pemberian makanan tambahan (MP-ASI) mencukupi empat kriteria: aman, responsif, cukup, dan tepat waktu. Di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Benowo, Surabaya, penelitian ini bertujuan untuk memastikan kesesuaian MP-ASI Kementerian Kesehatan untuk anak usia 12 hingga 24 bulan.

Metodologi *cross sectional* dan desain deskriptif digunakan dalam penelitian ini. Sampel penelitian terdiri dari 58 ibu dengan anak usia 12 hingga 24 bulan yang dipilih secara acak dan tinggal di sekitar Puskesmas Benowo. Informasi dikumpulkan melalui survei yang menilai kesesuaian pemberian MP-ASI sesuai dengan empat standar Kementerian Kesehatan. Analisis univariat kemudian dilakukan dengan SPSS.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan pemberian makanan tambahan tepat waktu dengan kategori cukup sebesar 15,5% dan kategori sangat baik sebesar 85,5%. Sesuai hasil penelitian, pemberian makanan tambahan gizi cukup terbagi dalam tiga kategori: sangat baik (56,9%), cukup (41,4%), dan kurang (1,7%). Sesuai hasil penelitian, pemberian makanan tambahan yang aman terbagi dalam kategori cukup (10,3%) dan sangat baik (89,7%). Sesuai hasil penelitian, pemberian makanan tambahan yang responsif terbagi dalam kategori sangat baik (81%), dan cukup (19%). Di antara kategori-kategori tersebut, 93,1% kategori mencukupi standar pemberian makanan tambahan, sedangkan 6,9% kategori tidak mencukupi standar. Standar Kementerian Kesehatan sebagian besar telah dipenuhi oleh program pemberian makanan tambahan untuk anak usia 12 sampai 24 bulan di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Benowo Surabaya

The Ministry of Health states that the supply of supplemental feeding (MP-ASI) satisfies four criteria: safe, responsive, sufficient, and timely. In the Benowo Community Health Center (Puskesmas) neighborhood of Surabaya, this research sought to ascertain if the Ministry of Health's MP-ASI was suitable for children ages 12 to 24 months.

A cross-sectional methodology and descriptive design were used in this investigation. 58 randomly chosen women with children between the ages of 12 and 24 months who lived in the vicinity of the Benowo Community Health Center made up the sample. The information was gathered via a survey that assessed the suitability of MP-ASI providing in accordance with the four Ministry of Health standards. SPSS was then used to do a univariate analysis.

The study's findings demonstrated the timely administration of supplemental food with an adequate category of 15.5% and an excellent category 85.5%. based on the study's findings, enough supplemental nutrition was provided in three categories: excellent (56.9%), sufficient (41.4%), and less (1.7%). Based on the study's findings, safe supplemental feeding was categorized as adequate (10.3%) and excellent (89.7%). According to the study's findings, responsive supplementary feeding was provided in the excellent category (81%), and the adequate category (19%). Among the aforementioned categories 93.1% of the category complies with the standards of supplemental feeding, whereas 6.9% of the category does not. The Ministry of Health's standards have mostly been completed by the Benowo Surabaya Health Center's work area's supplementary feeding program for children ages 12 to 24 months.
