

**EVALUATION OF PUSKESMAS SANITATION CLINIC PROGRAM  
(CIPP Model Sanitary Clinic Study and SWOT Analysis at Banyu Urip  
Health Center in Surabaya City in 2022)**

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**ABSTRACT**

There was a gap between the total visits of people with environmental-based diseases at the Banyu Urip Health Center in 2017 - 2020 of 17,189 and data on patients people with environmental-based diseases who visited the sanitation clinic still didn't met the 10% Puskesmas target in 2017, 2018, and 2019. The purpose of the study to evaluated the implementation of the Banyu Urip Puskesmas sanitation clinic program based on function of the Puskesmas.

The research design was a qualitative research using the CIPP evaluation model (Context, Input, Process, Product) which supported by SWOT analysis with a cross sectional design. The subject of this study is the Head of Puskesmas, Sanitarian, Nurse concerned.

Context evaluation included the good category, input evaluation included the sufficient category, process evaluation included the good category and product evaluation included sufficient category. So that overall the evaluation of the CIPP model on the implementation of the sanitation clinic program can be categorized sufficiently in the aspects of context, input, process, and product, all of which have a relationship between the aspects that exist in each component. Although in its implementation there was still some shortcomings that need to be optimized for the evaluation of each component, it was hoped that it can be used to improve the quality of the sanitation clinic program at the Banyu Urip Health Center.

It was recommended the Banyu Urip Health Center to make a commitment and policy to refer patients suffering from PBL to the sanitation clinic, focusing on counseling visitors / patients about the importance of sanitation clinics. It was hoped that The Banyu Urip Health will had operational funds for the sanitation clinic program, make a schedule for the implementation of sanitation clinic, and establish good cooperative relations between sectors in the Puskesmas work area.
